A LIFELONG PIKE EXPERIENCE

n March 29th, 2019, the newly initiated men of the Delta Mu Chapter of Pi Kappa Alpha officially joined the bonds of Phi Phi Kappa Alpha. Our chartering weekend was a fantastic experience for all with a Friday night initiation event between the Ogletree House and College Hall, Saturday installation ceremony at the Ogletree House and then our chartering banquet event Saturday night at Lake Terrace Convention Center. Several representatives from nationals took part in the ceremony including Graham Jewell, Rockhurst, Kappa Epsilon 13, KC Herman, South Dakota, Kappa Pi '14, JC Blackmon, Delta State, Zeta Beta '13, Tommy Walpole, University of Louisiana-Monroe, Eta Omicron '80 with a keynote address from International President Mark Dziaczak, Delta Nu at Wayne State '91. Also, Ed Langton '66 and Ron Davis '68 gave excellent insights into some of our history and how far we have come together as an organization. A total of 31 men are new initiates and carrying the flame of Delta Mu! A few of these members have graduated and will be joining our alumni association, so please welcome them.

A critical issue for the chapter continues to be building a strong group of leaders to maintain this new foundation that has been established. There will be a transition phase from many of the original men that are junior founders that will graduate over the 2019-2020 year. Nationals awarded the charter based on a conditional arrangement that factors monthly reporting of recruitment efforts in-coordination with the Alumni Advisory Board. This period of time will officially be a probationary period to end January 1st, 2020 as long as benchmarks of recruitment and retention occur. We, as alumni, can greatly assist by suppling names of young men going to USM in the Fall of 2019. So, if there are any possible legacy recruits please do not hesitate to let DMAA know and we will forward that information to the chapter.

Our focus also begins to shift now to reoccupancy of the Pike House. On May 24th, 2019 the Garnet and Gold Eagles Corporation was formed with the assistance of attorney member Henry Dick, III'88 to have housing corporation oversight associated with all future leases of fraternity housing at Southern Miss related to Delta Mu. Incorporation of this organization was established by members of your DMAA and Alumni Advisory Board, as follows: Ed Langton '66, Incorporator: Matt Perez '95, President; Robert Abbey '70, Vice-President; Ron Davis '68, Vice-President, David Krenning '96, Treasurer and Vic Purvis '63, Secretary. There will be annual meetings that work in-tandem with our DMAA annual meetings and elected positions at those meetings for individuals most interested in providing support for all things related to the Pike House. As we hope to gain more control over lease options related

to the house in upcoming years, this opportunity could grow into a more traditional land lease with a structure similar to other area universities. This summer. USM has committed to the following renovations of the Pike House: Replacement of fire alarm system, Installation of on-line card access electronic device at front door, Flooring replacement in 16 bedrooms and the fover/lobby area, Renovation of one of eight bathrooms with renovation of seven others in the summer of 2020, Rehanging of Pi Kappa Alpha Letters at front/ main entrance and Coat of Arms repainted where appropriate, Landscaping and Volleyball court sand replacement with the date of 8/9/19 as official move-in day. Also, we soon will be launching a Pike House fundraising campaign. This will ensure the chapter maintains a competitive housing position against other fraternities on the row and provides a comfortable venue for alumni events, as well. Much of the original contents from the house is currently in climate controlled storage in Hattiesburg and will be transferred back to the house once allowed.

We have planned to schedule the Delta Mu Alumni Association 8th Annual Meeting on the weekend of October 12th, 2019 at the Pike House in Hattiesburg to focus our attention and celebration on a true Homecoming for Delta Mu! Please plan to attend and enjoy a weekend of brotherhood with our business meeting to likely be Saturday morning in the old party room of the fraternity house. There will be more details to come! Please save the date!

Finally, we are very excited to announce that the Delta Mu Alumni Association has just been informed that we have earned the coveted William R. Nester award. This is an award that Pike Nationals gives annually to the top alumni associations within the entire organization. There are many men that have stepped up to the challenge over the last several years to build this organization as one of the most respected alumni associations within Pi Kappa Alpha. Thank you to all the Order of 1949 members that are truly Oak(s) of Delta Mu. We could not have gotten this far without you! Also, thank you for allowing me to serve as your President these last four years. Let's continue to build into a complete organization that shows valuable experiences for members no matter our ages as we progress through the stages of a lifelong Pike fraternity membership.






